Summer vacation season is upon us. As you schedule your trip, White Eagle is here with a few services and tips that could come in handy:

- Access more than 28,000 surcharge-free ATMs across the nation with your WECU debit card. White Eagle is part of the CO-OP Network that provides the nation's largest credit union electronic funds transfer network, with ATMs located in 50 states and 10 countries. Locations include other credit unions, convenience stores including 7-Eleven, supermarkets, malls, gas stations and stores such as Walgreens. To find a surcharge-free CO-OP Network ATM, go to www.co-opnetwork.org or call 888-SITE-COOP.
- CardValet is a mobile app that allows you to monitor debit card activity, temporarily turn off purchases/withdrawals from your card and set controls based on transaction amount, merchant type or location. Speak to a WECU member services representative for more information and to get set up.
