### **EMV Chip Cards Coming to White Eagle This Quarter**

Many of you may be familiar with the terms EMV or chip card since this topic has become buzz worthy in the financial world lately. For those of you who may not know, let us help you out with a brief overview of the technology and how it will be changing your White Eagle credit and debit cards in the near future. EMV, or Europay MasterCard and Visa, is a standard for credit and debit payment cards based on chip technology. There are several reasons the United States is migrating to chip-based cards, including improving security and enabling a better experience for international travelers.

#### When will EMV cards be available?

White Eagle Credit Union will have EMV cards available during the 2016 third quarter. You can follow us on social media to watch for an announcement or check back at your local White Eagle branch.

#### What do I need to do?

You do not need to do anything. You will be issued a new EMV card, at no cost, when your current card expires.

### What if I want to replace my cards before they expire?

You are welcome to purchase an EMV card for \$7.50 each to replace your current debit or credit cards before the expiration. If you choose to keep your card until it expires, that works too.

### How will online shopping change with a chip card?

Online shopping is the same as it has always been. Enter your card information, and have fun shopping!



#### How will EMV Cards benefit me?

EMV cards offer benefits to you as members and to the credit union. There is reduced fraud from counterfeit, lost or stolen cards, and there will be better experiences for our credit card holders during international travels because more merchants prefer EMV cards to the magnetic strip. These EMV cards are also paving the way for mobile payments and other applications.

#### How will I use this card differently when checking out?

Many companies are going to chip-enabled readers where you will put your card in a slot at the bottom of the reader with the chip end facing up. It will take time to process the transaction so make sure to follow the steps on the screen before removing the card. The terminal may ask you for a signature or pin after it processes your transaction. This will replace swiping your card.

### What if I have a chip card and the store does not have chip technology?

You can still swipe your chip card, and it will process using the magnetic stripe on the back, just like before.
